

# Reception Curriculum Plan for Spring 2018

## Our Curriculum:

- PSED (Personal, Social and Emotional Development) – Sharing with others and understanding how to be good friends
- PD (Physical Development) – Developing our fine motor skills and letter formation, as well as getting dressed and undressed independently
- C + L (Communication and Language) – Circle time, talk partners and role play
- L (Literacy) – Reading and writing simple words and sentences
- M (Maths) – Recognising numbers, being confident with the numicon resources, finding and making patterns, beginning to record numerals
- UW (Understanding the World) – Noticing and describing changes over time and patterns in the natural world; developing our computer skills in the Computing suite
- EAD (Expressive Arts and Design) – Colour mixing, constructing with different materials, exploring the sounds made by different instruments, exploring moving in different ways
