

Reading Records KS1

Your child should be reading 5-7 times per week. When you read to them or they read with your support, it is expected to be recorded in their reading record. In KS1, we expect that this will be written most often by an adult. Children in year 2 may begin to record their comment them self as they progress through the year. Please see below some examples of what can be recorded.



Reading Records KS2

Your child should be reading 5-7 times per week. When they read, it is expected to be recorded in their reading record. In KS2, we expect that this will be written most often by the children. Children may also read with an adult if they choose to. Please see below some examples of what can be recorded.



At every 25 night interval, children will be awarded a sticker in their reading record. A class poster is also used at school, where children can see how many stickers each child has.
