Our Curriculum:

Our work this term will be focussed on a range of topics, which include: transport, (cars and trains), and stories, (The Gingerbread man, We're Going on a Bear Hunt, The Little Red Hen, and The Great Pet Sale), alongside Mother's day and Easter. We will cover:

- Personal, social and emotional development
- Communication and language (speaking and listening)
- Physical development
- Literacy (reading and writing)
- Numeracy
- Understanding the world
- Expressive arts and design (creative activities including role play, art, music and dancing)

Within planned learning, we will be focusing on name writing for the Minus 1 children and name recognition for the new Minus 2 children, listening games, understanding 1,2,3,4 and 5, circles, triangles, squares and rectangles, as well as positional and directional language. We will be having regular phonic sessions and these will be looking at rhyme and alliteration. Please look out on Seesaw for further information.

What your child needs to bring to school every day:
