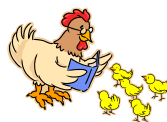

Nursery Visit to Sacrewell Farm, Wednesday 3rd May 2023

We are taking the children in the Nursery to Sacrewell Farm at Wansford on **Wednesday 3rd May** within normal nursery hours.

Sacrewell Farm is a working farm with cows, sheep, geese, hens and rabbits. There will be plenty of opportunities for the children to see lots of baby animals. We will be travelling to the Farm by coach.

The children must be at Nursery by 8.30am for the morning session, the coach will leave school at 9.15am. We will return to school by 2.45pm in time for Children who normally attend in the mornings only to be collected. Children who normally attend Nursery in the afternoon can be collected at the end of the day at 3.30pm

The children will need to wear wellington boots or shoes that can get muddy, and take another pair of shoes to change into for the return journey. We will be outside so waterproofs or a warm coat are essential. The children need to wear old clothes that you do not mind getting dirty. If the weather is hot and sunny please ensure that sunblock is applied **before** your child comes to Nursery. They will also need a sun hat or bobble hat dependant on the weather. **All children will need to bring a packed lunch from home.**

The children will be going on a tractor ride and feeding some small animals in a safe environment

The total cost of the trip including coach hire, entrance to the farm and insurance makes a total of £612.00, divided by 32 children makes a voluntary contribution of **£19.10 per child**. We are able to take online payments. If you wish to pay by this method, please log in to your account on **Parentpay**. If you have forgotten your log in details, please contact the office, who will be happy to help. Whilst this is a voluntary contribution, should enough support not be forthcoming we do reserve the right to cancel the trip. Unfortunately money cannot be refunded if your child is absent on the day of the visit as we are required to make the necessary payments in advance.

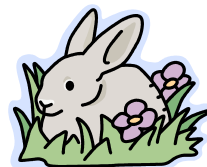
