## Year 2 visit to Hunstanton – Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> June

As part of our topic based on the story 'The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch' we will be visiting Hunstanton. The children will visit the Sealife Centre and find out more about the seaside and the animals that live in and around the sea. We will create art work on the beach and of course, make time for a paddle and an ice cream!

We will leave school at 8:00am so your child will need to be in school by **7.45am**. We aim to return to school by **approximately 4.00pm**.

The children will need the following:

- Suitable play clothes (not school uniform)
- Spare clothes (in case they get wet whilst paddling)
- Sun hat
- Sun cream (applied before leaving home)
- Comfortable shoes
- Rain coat
- Back pack to carry their belongings for the day

As we will be there for most of the day, your child will require a packed lunch and the school kitchen can provide a packed lunch or if you would prefer to send your own packed lunch from home. We will also be taking our school fruit snack with us and children can bring their school water bottles as normal.

The cost of this trip is: **£37** per child. If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium funding, we are offering a 50% discount of the price which makes the cost **£18.50 per child.** Your child may bring £5 spending money as we will be visiting the gift shop at the Sealife Centre; the cost of an ice cream is included in the price.





Payments and permission must be made by ParentPay as we are becoming a cashless school over the next year. If you have not registered for ParentPay or have forgotten your log in details, please contact the office, who will be happy to help.

We have agreed a payment plan to spread the cost of the trip as follows –  $\pm 10$  by  $3^{rd}$  November 2023  $\pm 10$  by  $2^{nd}$  February 2024  $\pm 10$  by  $8^{th}$  March 2024  $\pm 7$  by  $3^{rd}$  May 2024
