### **Year 3 Trip to Flag Fen – Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> May**

In order to fully understand our topic this term of Stone Age to Bronze Age Britain, Year 3 will be taking a day trip to Flag Fen Museum, Peterborough on **Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> May**.

In the morning we will be handling real and replica prehistoric objects and taking part in a clay craft activity. Flag Fen is famous for its prehistoric wooden causeway and platform so in the afternoon we will see the wooden timbers in situ – they remain where they were found by archaeologists – and take part in a guided tour of the Flag Fen site. We will participate as well in a story telling session in the Bronze Age Round House.

We will leave school at approximately 9.15am and will arrive back to school at approximately 2.50pm. The children must wear school uniform and bring with them, in a carrier bag, shoes or wellington boots suitable for a muddy environment in addition to shoes for indoors. They will also need a packed lunch (which must not include any nut based products) and a drink in a plastic container. If you are entitled to free school meals and would like the school to provide a packed lunch, please indicate on ParentPay. If you would like the school to provide a packed lunch at a cost of £2.50, please indicate on ParentPay, which you will need to pre-order by **Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> May**.

The cost of this trip including coach hire, the entrance fee and insurance is £16 per child. If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium funding, we are offering a 50% discount of the total price making a payment of £8.00. Payments and permission must be made by ParentPay as we are a cashless school and can no longer take payment in the office. If you have not registered for ParentPay or have forgotten your log in details, please contact the office, who will be happy to help. Whilst this is a voluntary contribution, should enough support not be forthcoming, we do reserve the right to cancel the visit.
