Our Curriculum

Topic –We will be learning about the human and physical features of our local area and making a map. In History we will be comparing the first planes to the present day. In art we will be practising sketching and drawing a picture by Michelangelo. In DT we will be making a vehicle.

Maths:

We will be learning different mathematic skills and using these to solve problems in:

Writing:

We will be covering a variety of different writing genres in Topic lessons. We will be writing a story, instructions, non-chronological report and letters.

Reading:

Your child will bring home a RWI book and a free reader each week. Please read with your child as often as possible and help them to fill in their reading record.

Homework:

Homework will be set each Friday, and children must submit their work by the following Wednesday. If you are not able to access Seesaw, please inform the class teacher.

Children also need to read each day, play Numbots and TT Rock Stars.
