We are very pleased to again be offering children an opportunity to see the pantomime at the Key Theatre. This is not a class visit, but a trip open to any child in KS1 and KS2 (Years 1 - 6). This year the performance will be Snow White.

#### The story of Snow White

**Snow White, a timeless tale of friendship, courage, and the triumph of good over evil. Join us as we follow Snow White on her magical journey, where she befriends the joyful dwarfs and faces the wicked queen.**

The children will be going to see the performance on **Monday 16<sup>th</sup> December 2024**. The performance will take place after lunch and is expected to last for approximately 2 hours; children and they should arrive back at school by approximately **4.30pm**.

The total cost of this visit will be **£16.00 per child**. If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium funding we are offering a 50% discount of the price which makes the cost **£8.00 per child**. Payments and permission must be made by ParentPay as we are becoming a cashless school over the next year. If you have not registered for ParentPay or have forgotten your log in details, please contact the office, who will be happy to help.

We have made a provisional reservation for 200 tickets but need to confirm final numbers with the Key Theatre by **Friday 11<sup>th</sup> October**. If you would like your child to take part in this visit please ensure that you pay online via ParentPay by **Friday 4<sup>th</sup> October**. **Unfortunately tickets cannot be purchased after this date.**

This visit is designed to enhance and enrich the wider curriculum and is open to all children in KS1 and KS2 (Years 1,2,3,4,5 and 6). It is not linked to a particular topic or subject and consequently tickets need to be paid for in full, not with a voluntary contribution.
