Our Curriculum

Children will be given the opportunity to explore:

- Geography – Where we are
- History – History of transport
- Art – Paper Sculpture
- Science – Everyday materials
- DT – Moving Pictures
- RE – Who made the words? / What questions does the Creation Story make us ask?

Maths:

- 3D and 2D shapes
- Numbers within 20
- Addition and subtraction within 20
- Numbers to 50
- Length and height
- Mass and capacity

Writing:

The key skills we will cover this term are how to write and punctuate simple sentences.

- Narrative – Peace at Last
- How to Catch a star
- Recount
- Information text
- Opportunities to do independent writing during continuous provision



Reading:

- Please read with your child as often as possible. There will be a reading challenge bookmark that will be given to your child each week, and this is to be uploaded to seesaw, where your child's class teacher will monitor their reading. Your child needs to complete a minimum of 3 challenges a week.
- One of these challenges will be from their Read, Write Inc phonics lessons and one a free choice book. The free choice book should to be enjoyed together by parent and child.

Homework: Phonics homework will be sent each Friday and needs to be completed by the following Wednesday

PE: Children should come to school wearing their PE kit on PE days:

Grey: Wednesday & Friday

PE lessons may be indoors or outdoors, so please ensure children have suitable shoes and warm clothes. Please follow the school guidelines for PE kits: black/grey tracksuit bottoms, black jumpers and plain white t-shirts. PE uniform must have no logos.

- On PE days, earrings should be removed at home or covered with tape.
