# Year 3 Spring Curriculum 2025

## Our Curriculum

### Topic - Explorers

- In Science, our topics are organisms and plants: the children will be learning about healthy eating, skeletons and how plants grow.
- In Computing the children will be creating using 'Scratch'.
- In DT the children will use their skills to sew pouches and in art the topic is fairytales. We will be using clay as part of our project.
- In Geography children will be learning all about the features of volcanoes: how they are formed and where they are found. In history they will be learning about Ancient Egypt.
- In PE they will learn skills to play invasion games and perform gymnastics.
- In PSHE the children will learn about how to resolve conflict and also about diversity and community.
- In RE the children will learn about how people make moral decisions and where Islamic beliefs come from.

### Writing:

- The children will be working on character description. We will be writing in different styles including a non-chronological report and a diary based on the books we have read. We will also be doing a recount.
- The children will be working hard on their spelling and handwriting throughout the term. Please continue to support them with these skills at home.

### Assemblies:

3W & 3D have their assembly in the summer term.

### Reading:

Please read with your child as often as possible. There will be a reading challenge bookmark that will be given to your child each week and this is to be uploaded to seesaw where your child's class teacher will monitor their reading. Your child needs to complete a minimum of 3 challenges a week which are to be uploaded onto seesaw.

### Maths:

- Multiplication and Division , including weekly times table tests
- Fractions.
- Length and perimeter.
- Mass and capacity.
- Worded Problems.
- Please use the school's calculation policy, available on the website, to support your child.

### Homework:

Homework will be set each Monday, and children must submit their work by the following Monday. If you are not able to access Seesaw, please inform the class teacher.

Children also need to read each day and complete their reading challenges, submitting these on Seesaw. Children should also be playing TT Rockstars regularly and completing their spelling activities.
