Our Curriculum

Topic:

- In our foundation subjects, we will be looking at tropical rainforests, the Early Islamic Civilisation and discovering how people contribute to society .
- In Computing, the children will be looking at repetition in shapes and photo editing
- In Science, the children will learn about and investigate 'States of matter and the particle model' and 'Sounds'.
- In Art and DT, the children will be learning about how pulleys work and will be creating a watercolour tropical rainforest.
- In PSHE, the children will start by looking at how to work together, financial responsibilities and then we will discuss sex and relationships.
- In PE, the children will be practising hockey and tennis, as well as skills from the Getset4PE scheme.

Writing:

- The children will be writing a range of genres including a non-chronological report about a mythical creature and a narrative about dragons, linking to our new book, 'Land of Roar!'

Reading:

Please read with your child as often as possible. There will be a reading challenge bookmark that will be given to your child each week and this is to be uploaded to seesaw where your child's class teacher will monitor their reading. Your child needs to complete a minimum of 3 challenges a week which are to be uploaded onto seesaw.

Maths:

- This year the children will continue to use the 'Power Maths' maths programme.
- We will begin by looking at multiplication and division, then move on to measurement and fractions.
- Application of skills, as well as reasoning and problem solving will also be focused on.
