# Year 4 Summer Curriculum 2025

## Our Curriculum

### Topic / Foundation subjects:

- In History we will be looking at local history, why this has played an important part in our community and how migration has shaped our community.
- In Science, the children will be learning about properties of materials and electricity. Developing their understanding of circuits and learning about physical and chemical properties of materials.
- In Computing, the children will be improving their photo editing skills.
- In Geography we will learn about earthquakes, why they take place and the effects they had in Haiti and Japan.
- In PSHE, the children will learn about managing risk and change.
- In PE, the children will be understanding and improving their fitness, learning how to play golf as well as working on their rounders and athletics skills.

### Writing:

- The children will be writing a narrative based around *The Thieves of Ostia*, the book we will be reading in DR.
- They will also be writing a persuasive letter.

### Reading:

We will be reading a book called 'The Thieves of Ostia' by Caroline Lawrence in Destination Reader.

- Please listen to your child read regularly.
- They should be reading at least 5/6 times a week.
- Please ensure your child is completing their reading challenges each week and uploading evidence on seesaw.

### Maths:

- The children will use the 'Power Maths' programme. We will be continuing to learn about fractions, time and then move on to learn about Geometry (angles, position and direction)
- Application of skills, as well as reasoning and problem solving will also be focused on.
- Please use the school's calculation policy to support your child.

### Homework:

Homework will be set each Friday, and children must submit their work by the following Wednesday. If you are not able to access Seesaw, please inform the class teacher. Children also need to read each day and regularly play TTRockstars, concentrating on the Soundcheck ready for the MTC National Test at the beginning of June. In the MTC children get to show that they have finished learning their Times Tables by scoring 25 out of 25.
