# Year 5 Summer Curriculum 2025

## Our Curriculum

### Topic:

In Geography in Summer 1, we will be learning all about the various climates around the world and how this impacts the living things from these areas. In History, we will be completing a project all about our local area. We will be drawing and creating different sculptures and artworks inspired by birds in Art and in DT we will be making some flat pack furniture to help the local environment. In RE, we will be learning about pieces of art and music inspired by Christianity as well as looking at how religion impacts people's lives.

### Writing:

Our writing will include various non-fiction genres including biographies of our heroes, persuasive writing, non-chronological reports, as well as story writing, which should be fun! We will be including lots of short bursts of writing and grammar games to encourage a love of writing.

### Reading:

Please read with your child regularly and complete the reading challenges with evidence recorded on Seesaw. We will be continuing to use the 'Destination Reader' scheme that develops the children's ability to talk about the books that they have read. We will be studying 'Who Let The Gods Out' by Maz Evans as well as the Eyewitness book all about Ancient Greece.

### Class Reader:

Rowling Class will continue with Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone and then read Fantastic Beasts and Where to Find Them. Cowell Class will read How to Train Your Dragon.

### Science:

In Science, we will be learning all about physics! Term one will see us learn all about forces and term 2 sees us explore space and Earth, leading to our inspiring trip to the National Space Centre in June.

### Maths:

- Area and Perimeter
- Geometry - Properties of Shape
- Decimals
- Negative Numbers
- Measure – Converting units

Please encourage your child to practice their times tables regularly on TT Rockstars.

### Homework:

Homework will be set each Friday, and children must submit an image of their work by the following Wednesday. If you are not able to access Seesaw, please inform the class teacher.

Children also need to read each day and play TTRS.
