Our Curriculum

Topic

This term our topic is inspirational people. We will start by learning about Martin Luther King and Rosa Parks, in the context of the civil rights movement in America. We will write a diary about Rosa Parks refusing to give up her seat on the bus. We will also be researching about Malala Yousafzai, Nelson Mandela, and Anne Frank. We will also be writing persuasive letters about educating girls and a narrative about discrimination. The children will also have an opportunity to research their own inspirational figure.

Science:

In science, we will be learning about Functions of the human body and chemical changes.

Reading:

Please read with your child as often as possible. There will be a reading challenge bookmark that will be given to your child each week and this is to be uploaded to seesaw where your child's class teacher will monitor their reading. Your child needs to complete a minimum of 3 challenges a week which are to be uploaded onto seesaw.

Class Text:

'No ballet shoes in Syria.' As part of our Destination Reader programme, the children will be reading a range of different texts. They will be learning the strategies of clarifying, predicting, inferring, questioning, evaluating, making connections and summarising.

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Maths:
