Our Curriculum

All work will be based around the 7 areas of the Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum, these are:

- Personal, Social and Emotional Development
- Communication and Language
- Physical development
- Literacy
- Mathematics
- Understanding the world
- Expressive arts and design (Including signing, painting, role play etc.)

During our Story Telling sessions, we will be reading and enjoying various fairy tales: including The Three Little Pigs and Little Red Riding Hood.

Within Literacy, we will continue to focus on name recognition and name writing; developing our mark making; learning set 1 RWI phonics sounds and pictures; and building phrases and sentences using Colourful Semantics.

In maths we will be working on counting and subitising, time; position and direction; comparing numbers; and measure.

On Friday 5th July at 9.45 we would like to invite you into the Potter classroom so you can see some of the activities that the children take part in during the school day and ask any questions in preparation for your child for September.

Where appropriate, children are supported to access whole class learning activities such as:

Books and Reading

Please read with your child regularly as this will help to encourage speech. In addition, try and join your local library then you will have a good selection of books to choose from.

What your child needs to bring to school every day

- Suitable clothes for the weather, but please ensure that your child has a jumper/cardigan/ coat at all times.

- Any outgrown Wellington boots will be gratefully received for us to use in school!
