Our Curriculum

Children will be given the opportunity to explore:

- Geography – There you are
- History – Homes through Time
- Art – The Natural World
- Science – Biology Humans/Biology Animals
- DT – Outdoor Space
- RE – Why are symbols important to Jewish families?/How do Christians show God is important to them?

The areas we will cover this half term are:

- Multiplication and Division
- Position and direction
- Numbers to 100
- Money
- Time
- Mass and Capacity
- Fractions

Writing:

In writing, we will be learning how to apply 'and' in our sentences. We will also be learning about improving our writing with including suffixes, prefixes, question marks and exclamation marks.

Reading:

- Children will be given two reading books a week. Please read at least 5 times and complete their reading challenges.
- One of these will be from their Read, Write Inc phonics lessons and one a free choice book. The free choice book is to be enjoyed together by parent and child.

Assemblies:

Year 1 have their assembly on Thursday 15th May 2025 at 2.45pm. Please come to see the great work we have been doing.

Homework:

- Phonics homework will be sent each Friday and needs to be completed by the following Wednesday. Spelling homework will be sent every Friday and children will be tested the following Friday.

PE: Children should come to school wearing their PE kit on PE days.

PE lessons may be indoors or outdoors so please ensure they have suitable shoes and warm clothes. Please follow the school guidelines for PE kits: black/grey tracksuit bottoms, black jumpers and plain white t-shirts. PE uniform must have no logos.
