Our Curriculum

Geography: we will be learning about rivers, seas and oceans, linking back to human and physical features.

History: we will be learning about explorers including Sacagawea and Micheal Collins.

Art: we will be linking to our topic on rivers by looking at how water is represented in art and practising with watercolours.

DT: we will be making a glove puppet.

Science: we will be learning about solids, liquids and gases and that some matter can change.

Religion and World Views: we will be learning all about Hinduism and how our senses play a big part in Hindu celebrations.

PSHE: we will be learning about sex and relationships, managing change and digital lifestyles.

Computing: we will be learning about algorithms, data and information.

Maths:

We will be learning different mathematical skills and using these to solve problems in:

- Length
- Fractions
- Statistics
- Time
- Measures
- Positions and directions

Writing:

We will be covering a variety of different writing genres in Topic lessons, including stories, instructions, recounts and letters.

Reading:

Your child will bring home a RWI book (phonics children only) and a free reader each week. Please read with your child as often as possible and complete the weekly reading challenges by uploading at least 3 pieces of evidence to Seesaw each week.

Please ensure your child has their books in their book bag every day.



Homework:

Homework will be set each Monday and Friday, and children must complete their work by the following Wednesday. If you are not able to access Seesaw, please inform the class teacher.

Children also need to read each day, and play TT Rock Stars.

PE: Children should come to school wearing their PE kit on PE days.
