Topic – What did the Greeks do for us?



Assemblies:

An assembly will take place on the 6th December at 2:30pm.

Homework:

This will be set on a Friday and needs to be returned by Wednesday. Children will be recording their homework in a yellow book, which needs to be handed in. Children will also be expected to practise their spellings and timetables at home weekly. These skills are essential for succeeding at school. Please read with your child as often as possible.
