Dear Parents/Carers

Year 6 visit to Imperial War Museum Duxford, Tuesday 5th November 2019

As part of our Autumn term topic we have arranged a visit to the Imperial War Museum at Duxford.

IWM Duxford is Britain's best-preserved Second World War airfield, with a fascinating history that dates back to the First World War. Its story reflects the landmark achievements made in aviation history.

Historic buildings sit alongside the striking contemporary exhibition halls; AirSpace and the American Air Museum. Through the rich displays of iconic aircraft and the powerful stories of the men and women involved, Duxford shows the impact of aviation on the nature of war and on people's lives.

With one of the finest collections of tanks, military vehicles and artillery, Duxford's Land Warfare exhibition, they show how technological development impacts on war and conflict.

The children will have an opportunity to explore the rest of the Duxford museum, where they will be able to see real military vehicles from the war and have a chance to view a reconstruction of the place where RAF Duxford's fighter aircraft were directed into combat during the Battle of Britain. The children will complete an educational question booklet that will guide them round the museum.

Our trip will take place on **Tuesday 5th November**. The coach will leave school at 9.00am so your child will need to arrive at school at normal time. We aim to return to school by **3:00pm**. Please could all children wear their normal school uniform and have a warm coat. The children will need a packed lunch and a drink in a plastic container. No glass bottles or cans please. If your child is entitled to free school meals and you would like the school to provide a packed lunch please indicate on the reply slip below. You will need to send a drink. If you would like school to provide a packed lunch at a cost of £2.20, please indicate on the reply slip below, which you will need to pre-order by **Thursday 31st October**.

The cost of this trip is: coach hire £625, entry to the museum £166.67 and insurance of £9.15 making a total of £800.82 divided by 61 pupils making a total of **£13.20 per child**. If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium funding we are offering a 50% discount of the price which makes the cost **£6.60 per child**. We are able to take online payments. If you wish to pay by this method, please log in to your account on **Parentpay.com**. If you have forgotten your log in details, please contact the office, who will be happy to help.
