Dear Parent / or Carer,

Mark Curtis here from Small Nose Productions. For a number of years we have been contracted to Lewisham Borough Council to deliver educational workshops based on the subject of The Kindertransport (Primary School), and The Holocaust (Secondary School).

We work with two survivors, Mrs. Liane Segal (former Mayoress of Lewisham) and Mrs. Rachel Levy BEM (Just recognized on the Queens honors list). Both of these ladies stories are exceptional in what they can teach us all about how to live our lives to the full.

Our work has led us into over 50% of Peterborough schools now. And this year we are delighted to be working with PKAT, Jack Hunt, Longthorpe, Thorpe, Middleton and Ravensthorpe.

We work with the young people in school by engaging them in practical activities that aim to help us better understand how these atrocities came to take place. The work has a real history focus.

Then we embark on a creative journey of discovery as we set about making a 5-minute piece of theatre with the young people. During this journey we offer plenty of room for moments of reflection on how the subject and the stories we follow can teach us wonderful things to better our own lives.

The final piece of work is then presented at Jack Hunt School on Wednesday 26th January at 6pm. Our dear friend and survivor of The Kindertransport, Mrs. Liane Segal will be in attendance.

We have loved working on this project over the years and have seen the change it can have on participating young people. It's a really positive and enlightening journey as we place emphasis on wellbeing and value. What do you value most in the world?
